These programmes provide professional training from experienced tutors on all aspects of governors' and clerks' roles, including Induction, crucial for all new governors and



clerks. Governors can view training opportunities and book sessions via the 'Oxfordshire Governor Services' tab on GovernorHub. For schools which subscribe to the service there are no additional costs, otherwise training may be undertaken on a pay-as-you-go basis, the expenditure being agreed with the school in advance.
